

The Stopper by CHS - INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Place surgical tray on top of desired sterile wrap.
- Lift each bottom corner of surgical tray and slide The Stopper Foot and Corner
 Protector under each foot and/or corner of tray.
- Repeat the above, only invert The Stopper Foot and Corner Protector to the top corners of the tray.
- If desired for maximum protection, place The Edge Protector on each side of the tray
- Once the protectors have been applied to all corners and edges, continue to wrap the surgical tray as per hospital/clinic/surgery center protocol.
- Once surgical tray is used/opened, return corner guards to Decontamination area.



The Stopper - Cleaning Instructions

Point of Use:

Remove soil with disposable cloth/paper wipe.

Cleaning:

Equipment:

Detergent, brush, running water

Note: Use only neutral (6.0-7.5) pH solutions, mildly alkaline and free of sodium carbonate to avoid damaging product. DO NOT USE scouring pads or abrasive cleaners.

Gross decontamination:

- 1. Remove all visible soil and contaminates using a soft bristle brush. The entire product should be immersed while cleaning to aid in the removal of contaminates and to reduce splashing of detergent on personnel.
- 2. Rinse thoroughly with clean water to remove all detergent. See rinsing instructions on the detergent label.

Automated Washer:

The **Stopper** cleaning process is reflected in the cycle detailed below:

Pre-Wash 1 & 2

Re-circulation Time 2 minutes
Water Temperature Cold Tap Water

Enzyme Wash: (1 oz/gal)
Soaking Time 4 minutes
Water Temperature Hot Tap Water

Wash 1:

Re-circulation Time 15 minutes Water Temperature Heated at 65.5°C

Rinse 1 & 2

Re-circulation Time 5 minutes
Water Temperature Hot Tap Water

Note: After completion of an automatic washer cycle, visually inspect the *The Stopper* for any remaining soil. All visible soil must be removed by hand cleaning, brushing and additional automatic cycles prior to sending to sterilization.
